RHEOFINISH® 299C is a solvent-free protective agent based on environment- and skin-friendly white oil. RHEOFINISH® 299C has been specially formulated to reduce adherence of concrete residues on the metal surfaces of machinery and equipment.

Fields of Application

RHEOFINISH® 299C may be applied on each type of concrete mixers and equipment, which is in contact with freshly-mixed concrete, mortar and plaster.

Features and Benefits

RHEOFINISH® 299C adheres to metal surfaces covered by a water film and also has an anticorrosive effect. $\text{RHEOFINISH}^{\circledR}$ 299C can be applied immediately after cleaning. It spreads underneath the surface water film consequently forms a highly adhesive protective coat. This coat makes it more difficult for residual concrete or mortar to adhere to the equipment and subsequently makes cleaning much easier. Any existing build-up is softened and gradually peels

Due to its white-oil basis RHEOFINISH® 299C is safe and eliminates many health environmental risks when compared to the traditional form release agents based on mineral oils. The workforce can therefore use it with the maximum confidence.

Application Procedure ${\rm RHEOFINISH}^{\rm @}$ 299C can be applied to mixers and machines immediately after cleaning with water. Drying of the surfaces is not necessary. It is a ready-to-use product that can be applied either by a sprayer, brush or a roller.

Coverage

The coverage of RHEOFINISH® 299C depends upon the application method. If applied uniformly by a sprayer at a constant pressure of 5 bars on metallic material the coverage rate is 30 - 40 m²/litre.

Storage

RHEOFINISH® 299C should be stored in their original sealed containers and at temperatures between +0 °C and +40 °C. If stored according to manufacturer's instructions, the shelf life is 18 months.

Handling and transportation

No special requirements need to be observed during use. Protection gloves and glasses are however recommended. Do not eat, drink or smoke during the application. RHEOFINISH® 299C is non-inflammable, non-toxic or irritant and is not subject to special transport requirements.
